

**ORDINANCE NO. 2016-2
CATERPILLAR TRAIL PUBLIC WATER DISTRICT
OF WOODFORD COUNTY, ILLINOIS**

**AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING NEW RATE SCHEDULES
FOR USE OF THE WATERWORKS SYSTEM OF
THE CATERPILLAR TRAIL PUBLIC WATER DISTRICT**

WHEREAS the Caterpillar Trail Public Water District operates and maintains a public water distribution system for the benefit of customers residing within its district pursuant to the Public Water District Act, 70 ILCS 3705/0.01 et seq.; and

WHEREAS the board of trustees of the Caterpillar Trail Public Water District has determined that it is necessary to establish new rate schedules for the provision of water in order to provide sufficient funds for the cost of maintenance and operation of the district, as well as for depreciation, capital improvements, and payment of principal and interest; and

WHEREAS, at a duly convened, regular meeting of the board of trustees of the Caterpillar Trail Public Water District held on December 14, 2015, the board voted to adopt new water rates, to become effective with the February 2016 monthly billing cycle;

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED by the board of trustees of the Caterpillar Trail Public Water District that the following rate schedules shall go into effect starting with the regular monthly billing cycle in February 2016:

RESIDENTIAL	
AND LOW USAGE COMMERCIAL ACCOUNTS:	
First 2,000 gallons per month	\$ 24.00
2,001 up to 10,000 gallons per month	\$ 7.00 per thousand
Over 10,000 gallons per month	\$ 10.00 per thousand
REGULAR COMMERCIAL ACCOUNTS:	
First 15,000 gallons per month	\$ 145.00
15,001 up to 40,000 gallons per month	\$ 7.00 per thousand
Over 40,000 gallons per month	\$ 10.00 per thousand

All other rate and fee ordinances previously adopted by the board of trustees of the Caterpillar Trail Public Water District which are not in conflict with this ordinance, including, but not limited to, application of the consumer price index, fees and interest for the filing of liens, as well as the loan service fee, fees for late payment, initial connection, reconnection after shut-off, and unauthorized use, and the labor rate and administrative fee, shall remain in full force and effect.


A copy of this Ordinance shall be published in the Peoria Journal Star and shall be made available to water customers on the Water District's website.
